

Weekly Weather Hazards Assessment

for Haiti



1) No rain has fallen since November. Any third season beans planted will likely have suffered failure. Top soil moisture shortages may hamper first season crop cultivation.



2) Meager rains have likely resulted in substantial third season bean crop yield and quality reduction or failure.

NOTE: The extent of the impact on agricultural production due to the lack of rainfall in the highlighted areas combined with the recent humanitarian crisis has yet to be determined.
